On this day, the Church invites us to pray for our priests. May their words always be Christ's words, their gestures always be Christ's gestures, and their lives always be a faithful reflection of His life. May they never become discouraged by the difficulties they encounter in their ministry, but rather energized by challenges which will guide them to look constantly and closely toward Jesus, who made the Cross the instrument of love and divine mercy, and who wants to transform the heart of every person.

In his recent Apostolic Exhortation, promulgated on April 9, Pope Francis speaks of the vocation to holiness of all the baptized regardless of their state of life. The pope affirms that, "Holiness consists in a habitual openness to transcendence, expressed in prayer and adoration. The saints are distinguished by a spirit of prayer and a need for communion with God" (Pope Francis, Gaudete et Exsultate, n.147).

Please continue to pray for our priests. May we, priests, religious and laity, young and old, be united in prayer. May we all strive to be holy, as our heavenly Father is Holy.
